

Fabric Boxes 1

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We will make two boxes (square & recipe) in class. Please check the supply list carefully. Please email me if you have questions!

Supply List:

sewing machine **in good working order**, able to do a good satin stitch and free arm capability
open toed embroidery foot for your machine
sewing machine needles: size 80/12 - **top stitching**
thread + 2 filled bobbins for each of two boxes
white thread + 1 bobbin of white thread
scissors for thread & fabric cutting
double curved, duck billed appliqué scissors, optional, but an excellent tool
seam ripper
straight pins I like the flat, flower headed pins
rotary cutter & large rotary cutting mat
12 ½" square rotary ruler
hot iron cleaner
ironing protective sheet - to protect ironing board (I use June Tailor, 18" sq)
extra irons & ironing boards would be helpful - bring a cloth to cover & protect the surface of your board
3 yards of non-fuzzy cotton cording, yarn, or string about 1/8" thick
Heavy duty extension cord & strip

Fabric:

2 fat quarters each for two boxes - 4 fat quarters total
If you bring more, you will have more options!

Please be brand specific on these two:

Timtex or fast2fuse (@ ½ yard)
Wonder Under, @ 2 yards (less if you use fast2fuse!)
