

Weeklies 2 – Small Art Quilts

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Class 2 Supply List: Freehand Curves

Sewing machine in good working order.

If you don't have these feet or know what they are, ask your local shop. Please have them for class. They will make your sewing so much easier.

Darning foot – open or closed (Bernina #15 or # 24) (optional after first class)

Open toed Embroidery foot (Bernina # 20)

Topstitch needles, 80/12 or 90/14. These needles are sharp, have a larger eye and a larger shaft up the back to protect the thread. Sharps are ok, Universals are not!

Thread

Cotton or polyester in whatever colors you want to work with.

A neutral color for the bobbin, or one that matches your backing

Superior polyester monofilament thread

Fabric

Fat quarters or scraps of 3 -5 fabrics for a landscape

5 fabrics for a freeform piece – color coordinated, & a good value range

6 fabrics for a freezer paper piece – color coordinated

@ 10" x 12" thin (cheap!) neutral cotton or muslin

Batting & backing

@ 10" x 12" of backing fabric

@ 10" x 12" piece of low loft cotton batting –Hobbs 100% cotton is what I use.

Rotary Cutting Equipment

12 ½" square ruler – only for squaring up at the end!

Rotary cutter

Rotary mat – 18" x 24"

1/2 yard freezer paper

Marking pencils/pens

Straight Pins – I like the flat flower head ones

Small iron & ironing mat
