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## Class 3 Supply List: Fusing

### **Sewing machine in good working order.**

If you don't have these feet or know what they are, ask your local shop. Please have them for class. They will make your sewing so much easier.

Darning foot – open or closed (Bernina #15 or # 24) I prefer open toed.

Open toed Embroidery foot (Bernina # 20)

**Topstitch needles**, 90/14 or 80/14 - These needles are sharp, have a larger eye and a larger shaft up the back to protect the thread. Universal needles are not ok.

### **Thread**

Cotton or polyester in whatever colors to go with your fabrics

A neutral color for the bobbin, or one that matches your backing

Superior polyester monofilament thread

### **Fabric**

Scraps or fat quarters of fabrics that you want to work with – plan on making three small pieces in class. Bring a minimum of 4 sets of 4 – 7 coordinated fabrics. One of them should include a small design/flower/leaf that you will cut out.

¼ - ½ yard dark tulle

@ 9" x 12" piece of muslin or scrap fabric

### **Fusibles**

1 yard Wonder Under fusible web or Steam-A-Seam 2

½ yard Pellon Shirttailor Interfacing

@ 10" x 12" Fast2Fuse and scraps

### **Rotary Cutting Equipment**

12 ½" square ruler

Rotary cutter & rotary mat – 18" x 24"

### **Miscellaneous**

Small iron & ironing mat

Protective Teflon sheet for ironing board

Freezer paper

Tracing paper – 2 sheets

3 – 4 sheets of tracing paper

Pencil & eraser

Small sharp (curved blade) embroidery scissors or double curved duck billed appliqué scissors
